**Morning Prayer** is said in the Lady Chapel each Wednesday at 9 am.

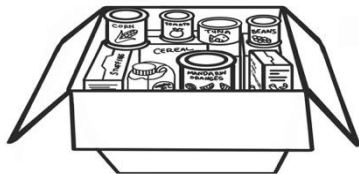
**The Holy Eucharist** is celebrated in the Lady Chapel, Thursday's at 10 am.
